I. Purpose of the Job:

To actively support the management of custodial, maintenance, and grounds operations for the facility, playing a vital role in bringing Citygate Church's vision to life.

II. Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

Weekly Responsibilities (before Sunday)

- Work closely with the Global Operations Director on campus repair and improvement projects
- Assist Campus Operations Technician with campus evaluation and inspections.
- Work closely with Campus Operations Technician and Campus Custodial Technicians to help run all facets of Facilities
- Understand fire alarm systems and possess ability to teach each campus intricacies
- Responsible for making sure HVAC is functioning as designed, including duct sensors
- Ensure that all facilities request are completed by their assigned due dates
- Responsible for making sure as best possible everything is in working order for services, events, and conferences
- As scheduled, to be on call for all campuses during services
- As scheduled, to come in on days you are on call to handle emergencies
- Be part of the planning process for all events, coordinating with the events team
- Coordinate with all indoor and outdoor facilities departments prior to an event to be sure all electrical, plumbing, grounds keeping etc. needs are met
- Aware of all electrical, plumbing, HVAC, and structural projects of the campus
- Demonstrate adaptability and willingness to oversee various projects as needed
- Train staff members how to access and secure the building

Sunday Responsibilities

- Responsible for ensuring the building is 100% ready for services with everything in working order.
- Set HVAC temperatures
- Always on call to serve/react to emergencies
- Responsible to make sure buildings are locked and secure after services

Monthly Responsibilities .

- Create a monthly serve and mtg schedule for the department.
- Monthly training with your departments to train, cast vision, and build community
- Stay 4 months ahead on up and coming church and community events
- Nominate and celebrate Crew Leaders and members monthly

Special Events Responsibilities

- Responsible to ensure the building in preparation for services
- Responsible for making sure as best possible everything is in working order for events, and conferences
- Responsible to make sure buildings are locked and secure after all events
